Almost Ready-to-Fly .60 Sport/Pattern Plane



## Classic precision – modern ARF ease.

A classic Joe Bridi design that became a popular Great Planes kit, the Dirty Birdy accurately followed a pilot's most intricate commands. This updated version combines that precision performance with ARF simplicity, easy sport flying and nostalgic pattern looks.

- Painted fiberglass fuselage with removable, painted fiberglass cowl.
- Balsa-sheeted horizontal stabilizer halves slide onto carbon fiber tubes, aligning perfectly, securely and automatically.
- All control surfaces are factory-hinged for fast final assembly.
- Wells are built-in for optional pneumatic or mechanical retracts, but covered to preserve the model's looks if you install the included fixed landing gear.
- Easily accommodates a standard muffler or tuned pipe — a wooden hardpoint is built into the wing for secure tuned pipe attachment.
