## The NEW Camaro

After a long absence, an all-new Camaro has hit the streets and it's better than ever. With styling reminiscent of the famous 1969 Camaro, this 2010 version has been instantly popular. Equipped with the 400 horsepower L99 V-8 and automatic transmission, the 2010 Camaro achieves 0-60 mph in 4.6 sec. and the measured quarter mile in 13.1 second.

With the leader in the new age pony-car category going retro styling, Chevy had no choice but to follow and put the best package forward. The new Camaro is built on GM's Zeta full size chassis platform with full independent suspension. The

base engine is the 3.6 liter V-6 with 304 horsepower. Of course in the pony-car wars only a V-8 will do and the new Camaro V-8 has 400 horsepower and 410 pounds of torque.
