

Official Rules for the Top Flite® MonoKote® 40th Anniversary ARF & Kit Covering Contest

The Top Flite MonoKote 40th Anniversary Covering Contest (hereafter referred to as the "Contest") will begin on April 9, 2010. All entries must be received by midnight, September 15, 2010. The Contest is sponsored by Hobbico®, Inc., 2904 Research Road, Champaign, Illinois 61826 (hereafter referred to as the "Sponsor"). Participation in the Contest is open to any individual who: 1) is age eighteen or older and a legal resident of the United States, the District of Columbia or Canada (hereafter referred to as the "Entrant"), and; 2) submits a completed entry form and photos of an R/C airplane that satisfies the contest rules (hereafter referred to as the "Entry.")

The Sponsor's employees and immediate families and the employees and immediate families of all affiliates, subsidiaries, distributors, promotional, advertising and fulfillment agencies assisting with this Contest (hereafter known collectively as "The Sponsor") are ineligible for participation in the contest.

How to Enter: To qualify for prizes, the Entrant must: 1) completely recover an ARF R/C airplane model or cover an R/C airplane model kit in an original trim scheme using Top Flite MonoKote film, and; 2) submit, online or by mail: a) a completed entry form, and b) up to five photos of the model to Hobbico, Inc. Entries submitted by either method must be received by Hobbico by midnight, September 15, 2010. Materials submitted through the mail should be sent to: Hobbico®, Inc., 2904 Research Road, Champaign, Illinois 61826, and include "Attn: MonoKote 40th Anniversary Covering Contest" under the zip code. Entrant may submit any number of Entries, but must submit a separate form and photos for each entry. Videos may not be substituted for "still" photography. *Please do not send either videos or completed models* to Hobbico, as neither will be returned. If photos are sent by mail, Entrant should identify each one by printing asterisked (*) entry form information on the back.

What to Enter: An Entry must be an R/C airplane covered (or recovered) in an original design created and applied by the Entrant using MonoKote Film. Trim schemes which have been previously published or entered in previous MonoKote contests are ineligible for consideration. Acceptable R/C airplanes include, but are not limited to, airplane kits and ARFs made by: Top Flite®, DuraPlane™ by Great Planes, Dynafly™ by Great Planes, Carl Goldberg™ Classics by Great Planes, Great Planes®, ElectriFly™ by Great Planes, Hobbico®, Flyzone™ by Hobbico and Phoenix Models®.

When to Enter: Entrants can submit Entries as of April 9, 2010. All Entries must be received by midnight, September 15, 2010. Entries received before April 9 or after midnight on September 15 will not be considered for judging, nor will Entries which do not meet Contest requirements. Sponsor reserves the right to disqualify an Entry at its own discretion.

What You can Win: There are six prizes in all. Entries will be divided into Kit and ARF categories, and first, second and third place winners will be selected in each category. Prizes are as follows:

Two Grand (First) Prizes: a \$1,000 shopping spree

Two Second Prizes: a \$500 shopping spree

Two Third Prizes: a \$250 shopping spree.

All prizes will be awarded. Prizes awarded to winners who cannot be contacted within seven working days of notification, or who fail to submit the required paperwork within fourteen working days will be considered undeliverable, and will be awarded to an alternate selected by the Judges. All decisions of the judges are final.
